### 19-21 July 19 – 21 Beer Festival – Musical Nights



The summer festivities will begin on the weekend of July 19 – 21 with the beer festival. Plenty of beer will be offered to the visitors throughout the weekend courtesy of the Lakonian brewery "SPARTAN BEER".

The Opening of the Art Exhibition "A Painting by our Artists" with works of local artists will take place on Saturday, July 20, 8:00 p.m. Faithful to its cultural mission, our Association has invited our compatriots to present their artwork. Accepting the invitation, the icon painter **Andriana Parisi**, the artists **Ioannis Goudes**, **Stefanos Melehes**, and the **Sioutou family** will participate in the exhibition. The Syrian painter **Sayer El Nazar** will also present his paintings of Karyes landscape. The exhibition will be open to visitors throughout the summer. A musical program will follow offered by the village's young musicians.



The events will culminate on the evening of Sunday, July 21 with a traditional dance performance by the folk dance group of Skala, Lakonia.

### The summer programme divine liturgy at the Karyes chapels

According to **Father Eustratios**, during the summer season the following Divine Liturgies will take place in the chapels of the Karyes Parish:

- on June 17<sup>th</sup> (on the day of the Holy Spirit's feast) at the Aghia Varvara chapel,
- on July 1<sup>st</sup> at the Aghioi Anargyroi chapel,
- on July 7<sup>th</sup> at the Aghia Kyriaki chapel,
- on August 15<sup>th</sup> at the Panaghia (Dormition of Our Lady -Virgin Mary) chapel,
- on August 29<sup>th</sup> at the St. John chapel at the Community Clock and
- on September 8<sup>th</sup> at the chapel of the Birth of Virgin Mary at the "Fotinou" settlement.

All the other Sundays, the Divine Liturgies will take place in the church of Aghios Andreas (St. Andrew) or Aghia Paraskevi.

### ANNOUNCEMENT BY THE MANAGEMENT ASSOCIATION OF PANAGIOTIS KERCHOULAS TRUST

After 33 years the donation of the assets in KERCHOULAS Legacy, which amount to **US\$ 1,507,955.60**, was finally granted to its beneficiaries, the residents of Karyes, giving them the opportunity to develop their hometown in the way their noble late expatriate benefactor, Panagiotis Kerchoulas, had envisioned and always longed for deep in his soul. Generation after generation, the Karyates will always honor him and other great benefactors and donors together with our compatriots who sacrificed their lives so that we can enjoy our freedom.

This advancement is the result of the motivation of Karyes society as well as the management of the committee that was elected by the residents at the historic General Meeting on October 22, 2017, where the following decisions were unanimously made:

1. The sustainable exploitation and management of the aquatic resources of Karyes is of vital importance and was agreed by everyone.
2. The implementation of smaller scale projects in the sectors of Tourism and Culture.
3. The support of local producers under established rules and regulations.
4. The utilization of the remaining funds according to the resolutions of a General Meeting in the future
5. Resolutions on the return of the stolen Karyatid and the exposure of Karyes as the birthplace of the Karyatids.
6. The mission of the elected committee to select and establish the most appropriate legal scheme for the management of the Legacy and the preparation of a programmatic commitment with the Holy Metropolis of Monemvasia and Sparta.

A special thank you goes to **Ms. Litsa Flori** who was in charge of the decorations and to **Ms. Lefki Latsi** (member of the Executive Council of the Karyates Association-S.A.K.) who took care of the costumes of the boys and girls who accompanied the Epitaph.

Consequently, the Church of Aghios Andreas was full on **Holy Thursday** at the Liturgies of the Crucifixion and the 12 Apostles.

On **Good Friday** at noon time, the Epitaph was decorated at the church of Aghios Andreas and in the evening it was carried across the village followed by many people to the Holy Church of Aghia Paraskevi. This year, like every year that ends in an odd number, the Resurrection took place in Rachi.

The members of the Ecclesiastical Council and the Cultural Club had taken care both of the impressive decoration of the Epitaph and the decoration of the path with grand lights that created a "luminous path of devoutness."


INTERNATIONAL MOUNTAIN BIKE RACES IN KARYES



After an absence of several years, the sport of mountain bike racing came back to Karyes again on April 7, 2019. The races were held under the auspices of the **Union Cycliste Internationale (UCI)** and were approved to award points that qualify for the 2020 Tokyo Olympics. Consequently, a great number of athletes from many countries across the world participated in the races. More specifically, we had athletes from **Greece, Russia, Japan, Czech Republic, Romania, Georgia, France, Italy, Bulgaria, and Lebanon**. The Municipality of Sparta, the Athletic Association of the Municipality, the Gymnastics Club of Sparta, the **Karyes Cultural Club**, and Alterbiketours were co-organizers of the event.

The big winner of the races was the Greek champion **Periklis Ilias**, who won the gold medal and ranked 1st in the general classification. He stood in the middle of the podium with **Sergey Nikolaev** from Russia, silver medal, on his right, and **Aleksandar Aleksiev** from Bulgaria, bronze medal, on his left.

The spectators who attended the event were impressed by the beauty of the landscape and the hospitality of the residents.

THE FESTIVALS IN KARYES IN THE 20<sup>TH</sup> CENTURY

Summer is here and our compatriots are looking forward to our traditional festivals that take place every year in Karyes. The famous feasts in Arachova are a tradition with roots that disappear down the centuries. We are all, more or less, aware of the modern way of celebrations with the morning church service followed by a feast in the main square of the village in the evening. But what was the traditional way our ancestors celebrated in the old times and especially before the village got access to electricity in the 1950s?

If we look at the old descriptions that can be found in publications about the village of Karyes, we can collect a lot of information on the theme. As mentioned in the folklore study "KARYAI (Arachova) LAKEDAIMONOS" by the late professor Mr. Konstantinos M. Pitsios, the festivals were scheduled at the time of the year when practically "the harvesting of crops operations were completed and the farmers, rested now, were looking forward to the festivals not only to show their appreciation to God for allowing them to have yet another successful year but to also reward themselves with the ancient sacrifice to God Dionysus-Bacchus and the joy of dance that continues the centuries-old tradition of the worship of Artemis Karyatis."

26 July – Festival of Aghia Paraskevi

The houses were cleaned several days before the celebration and everything was ready on July 26, the day of the commemoration of Aghia Paraskevi. In the morning, after attending church service, the people went in groups to the square of Rachi, where everything was set up for the celebration and the dance. The band sat at the center of the square and the lute player started playing the song that signaled the opening of the festival:

*"In the chapel of Aghia Paraskevi  
the young girl is sleeping alone.  
She is sleeping and dreaming  
that she is getting engaged."*

The musicians took shifts so that the dance could continue non-stop until the following day at noon time, when everyone left to go home and have some rest.

The dance started again in the afternoon and continued until dusk, when the best dancers gathered in a circle to dance and sing the local Arachovitiko dance. Then, people greeted each other, left from the square and the dance carried on in their houses until late at night.

27 July – Festival of Aghios Panteleimonas

The following day, the service took place at the Holy Church of Aghios Ioannis at Roloï, where the icon of Aghios Panteleimonas was kept. A similar celebration took place at the nearby Charakeiko Aloni.

At noon, the dance stopped for a while to continue later at Aghios Andreas square until dusk.

As the icon is now kept at the Holy Church of Aghios Andreas, the morning service takes place there as well.

OTHER CELEBRATIONS DURING THE YEAR

Except for the famous festivals, there were other celebrations and festivities that took place during the year, where the Karyates had the chance to take a break from their daily duties and enjoy themselves

"Apokries" Carnival

After the last Sunday of "Apokries", on Clean Monday, the "alevromoutzouroma" or "flour war", an old custom took place where young and older people blackened their faces with ashes or threw flour at each other.

August 15<sup>th</sup>: The Assumption Of Virgin Mary

On the day of the Assumption of Virgin Mary, the Karyates gathered at Aghios Andreas square to celebrate after the service at the church of the Assumption at the ancient planes was over.

Up until the 1950s, for the first two days after Easter, it was the custom of the Arachovites to gather and dance at the two main squares of the village. On Easter Monday, they gathered at "Central Square" (upper village) and on Easter Tuesday at the "Rachi Square" (lower village).

The most appropriate legal scheme was selected and established on **September 8, 2018**. It was comprised of 180 founding members. The legalization procedures were completed towards the end of the year 2018.

The members of the Executive Board as well as the members of the Audit Committee were elected at the elections held at the First General Meeting of the Association, on **March 24, 2019**. All members are distinguished individuals for their intellectual poise, professionalism, status, responsibility, knowledge and capabilities, as well as their ethos and diverse accumulated collective experience that comes from over 300 years of duty. These personality traits won them the unconditional trust of the noble expatriate benefactor Grandpa Panos Kopsiaftis, who guaranteed the total assets of the trust, and the Honorable Metropolitan of the Holy Metropolis of Monemvasia and Sparta, **Mr. Efstathios**, who after managing to bring the total amount of money in Greece several years ago, he then transferred it to the bank account of the Association.

We are at the disposal of anyone who would like to be further informed about all that has taken place over the last five years and especially during the period between the General Meeting of the residents of Karyes on **October 22, 2017** and now.

May the below mentioned set an example and be an inspiration to us all:

- The noble act of the late Panagiotis Kerchoulas to donate all his life savings in order to create opportunities for the young people of Karyes to stay in their homeland.
- The exemplary life attitude of the generous Grandpa Panos Kopsiaftis to ensure that the Karyates are not deprived either of the most precious thing in life, water, or the opportunities created by the Kerchoulas Trust.
- The motivation of the society of Karyes to claim its rights to possession of the property, thus confirming the effectiveness of collaborative actions.
- The collective voluntary effort of all members, including those who managed to achieve the assignment of the Kerchoula Trust, to overcome the obstacles and ensure targeted results, mainly because of their unwavering commitment to the mission they undertook on behalf of the residents of Karyes.

A prominent Karyatis died: Dimetrios Ioan. Prekezes



Dimos Prekezes drew his last breath on May 21, 2019 at his house in Kifissia at the age of 92.

He was born in **1927** at Karyes, Lakonia, and he was the second of the four children in the family of Giannis and Chrysoula Prekeze. His good parents, with their hard work, helped their children to complete their first years of education at the school in the village and then at the High School of Sparta and their reward was to see them both doctors.

Dimos excelled as a student both at school and the Medical School of the University of Athens, and he was an exemplary young man. Unfortunately, the destructive war, the German occupation, and the civil war ruined his life and his dreams and our country overall.

Chasing his dream for a better life, he went to America, where he settled in Chicago and he was a distinguished surgeon that practiced his skill for forty years. Handsome in appearance and with a kind soul, he offered his medical services to the people, often for free, staying faithful to the Hippocratic Oath during his whole life.

He got married to an exceptional Greek ex-patriate, **Kalliopi Doriza**, who became an excellent wife and a mother of four children. She raised her children with the Greek ideals, taught them the Greek language and inspired them with her love for Greece and her homeland, Patmos island. Dimos was very respectful to his parents and supported and assisted them to overcome the difficulties in their lives. Dimos and Kalliopi provided for their children to continue their studies and become respectable members of Chicago community, the city where they live. His two daughters, Irene and Ioanna, took care of him during the last years of his life and said the last goodbye to him at the Cemetery of Kifissia.
