The Celebration of the Saint Demetrios and the National Holiday of "OHI"

With a beautiful sunshine, the Christians went to the Chapel of Agios Demetrios in the Vergatsoula neighborhood to attend the Divine Liturgy honoring the memory of the Saint, led by Father Grigorios on **October 26**. At the end bread was distributed by the ladies of the church-council and the usual raffle for gifts followed to further its causes. Afterwards those celebrating their name day offered coffee and sweets in the SAVAS cafeteria.





Two days later, the **National Day of October 28** was celebrated with splendor at the Karyes main Church of St. Andrew. The bell rang joyfully from early on and in the solemn eulogy of the day, the "*Hypermacho stratego ta nikiteria*" chant for our protection from the Mary Mother of God was chanted by Father Leontios.

Afterwards, the students of the Karyes Primary School enthusiastically recited poems and sang songs about the anniversary and "OHI/NO".

At the Monument Statue of Nike, a memorial service was held and wreaths were laid by representatives of the local authorities and by a student of the Primary School. Finally, a minute's silence was observed in memory of our glorious dead.

Karyes: A worldwide destination for MOUNTAIN BIKE

In the fall of 2022, international cycling races were organized in Karyes for the umpteenth time in recent years. Specifically, for four days from Thursday 10/6 to Sunday 10/9, Karyes was once again at the center of international cycling interest, with the holding of the **International Mountain Bike Races**.

The races were included in the program of the World Cycling Federation (UCI) and are, among other things, the objective of collecting points for men and women, in view of the Olympic Games Paris 2024. Thus, big names of the sport were present, offering unique moments in the races, ensuring at the same time, valuable points for qualifying for the Olympic Games in 2024. Cyclists from Greece, Cyprus and Europe (France, Denmark, Switzerland, Slovakia, Israel, Belgium, Ukraine, Germany, Bosnia-Herzegovina) took part, as well as from countries as far away as New Zealand and Mexico (a total of 16 countries).



Leading the medal haul was **Denmark** with 6 gold, 1 silver and 2 bronze, followed by **Switzerland** with 2 gold, 5 silver, 2 bronze, **Greece** with 2 gold and 1 silver, **France** with 1 gold, 1 silver and 2 bronze, **Belgium** with 1 gold, 1 silver and 2 bronze, **Germany** with 1 gold and 2 bronze, **Bosnia and Herzegovina** with 1 gold, 2 silver, **Slovenia** with 3 silver and **Israel** with 1 bronze.

The races took place every morning, while at the same time at noon on Saturday 8/10, **Intercollegiate Races** were held, included in the Program of the **Hellenic Cycling Federation**, in the categories of teenagers, youths, children and mini.

The races were supported by the Sports Organization of Sparta, the Municipality of Sparta, the Spartan Gymnastic Club, the Karyes Local Community, the Karyes Cultural Club and thanks to the expertise of AlterBike Tours. Also valuable is the contribution of National Centre of Health Immense Help (E.K.A.B.) Sparta and the Nephrological Center of Sparta (NE.K.A.S.), for the provision of ambulances.

The games were honored with their presence by the Mayor of Sparta Mr. Petros Doukas, the Deputy Governor of Lakonia Mr. Nikon Tzinieris, the President of the Sports Organization of Sparta Mr. Stavros Pergantis, the former Mayor and head of the main opposition Mr. Stavros Argitakos, the President of the Karyes Local Community Mr. Georgios Devekos, the Municipal Councilors Mr. Ioannis Karmoiris and Mr. Konstantinos Stamatis and the President of the Spartan Gymnastic Club Mr. Panagiotis Pristouris.

Harmonization of the Statute with the New Sports Law 4726/2020

On February 13, 2022, the Sports Club General Assembly took place the club members approved the proposal by the Board of Directors concerning the **Statute amendment** in order to harmonize it with **the New Sports Law 4726/2020**. Forty-seven (47) signatures were immediately collected and with all the necessary supporting documents, the approval process was assigned to a lawyer. Finally, on October 6, 2022, the lawyer received Order No. 24/2022 of the Sparta Court of Law, where the Amendments were approved (article 4, paragraph 7, case B, 6, 8 and 9, while a new article was added, which numbered as 7).


The Club's participation at the Motor Race SCRAMBLE

- 4. Issuance of a building permit (D.O.Y./Tax office of Sparta) € 263.93 Duplicate.
- 5. Registration Fee for Arbitrary Buildings € 250.50 Form Law 4495/17.
- 6. Temporary Promissory Note (Public Insurance fee) € 30.00 Promissory note.

New signposts have been placed at the initiative of the Sports Club, since the old ones placed in 2004 have been worn out.








A famous Karyatis passed away

Paris K. Diamantouros



passed away in Athens on December 13, 2022, at the age of 87 The deceased was born in Athens (Kypseli) in 1935 and his family came from Arachova (Karyes) Laconia. In 1965, he married Despina (Depi) Papakonstantinou (1939-2014). He was a graduate of the Athens College and of Athens University Law School. He worked from 1960 in the family company that trading cereals and other products and which had founded by his grandfather Paraskeas Diamantouros in 1890, until 1997, when he retired.

He was president of the Piraeus Commodity Exchange (1975-1989) and a member of the Piraeus Chamber of Commerce and Industry BoD. He also served as president of the Hellenic Procurement Institute (1982-1984) and as president of the Greek Cereal Traders Association BoD (1984-1991). He was also an author. His works were: "The jaws of power", "The Diamantoureans", "The financing of our politicians". From 2004 to 2013 he wrote articles for the monthly magazine "Elea / Ηλαία", where he was editor-in-chief (2008-2013). In 2014 he lost his wife and retired from everything, until the end of his life, living with his beloved daughter Iro. His funeral took place in the First Cemetery of Athens in a close family circle.
