



## **Karyes Parish**

The great annual summer religious celebrations of Karyes/Arachova, those of **Agia Paraskevi on July 26**<sup>th</sup> **and of Agios Panteleimon on July 27**<sup>th</sup>, apart from their annual religious character, this year were also an opportunity for the congregation to admire the renovated Churches up close.





The image of the interior of the Church of Agia Paraskevi is truly beautiful. In the previous issues we mentioned those who had contributed financially to the renovation of the icon of the Sanctuary.

The oil painting work of the Temple has now been completed. All the work was done under the close supervision of the Archaeological Service of Sparta since the temple is from the 16th century.

In his speech, Father Leontios, among other things, mentioned that all the Karyates should be proud given that the projects were financed from the income of the **Parish Fund, that is, from the contributions of all of us**.

It should be noted that the Troulos with the Pantocrator and the spherical triangles were painted at the expense of **Mr. Vassilios Matalas** for the health of his wife, children and grandchildren.

On July 27th at the celebration of the memory of Agios Panteleimon in the Church of Agios Andreas where the icon of the Saint is located, A **memorial service at the end of the Solemn** Liturgy was also held in favor of Church benefactors and donors, on July 27th.. The congregation saw a Temple with a new roof and new marble steps in all exits.

#### Dear compatriots and friends.

We live in a place that has become known as for its ancient and old history first as for its current life. This is evidenced by the marble commemorated plaques mentioned not only the era of each project realization, but also the number of benefactors and donors.

Ladies and gentlemen, in the life of every area, the various social and economic conditions and situations dictated from time to time, the overwhelming need that has been evident for decades to change things, to carry out projects to improve the life of the place.

Thus, for the older to remember and the younger to learn, here in Karyes, the well-known Arachova, projects of enormous importance and value were carried out: The aqueduct, the school, the stadium, the clock, the main church of Agios Andreas, the Community Hall, the lake, the squares and so many other smaller ones that continuously and systematically help to improve the life of our small area.

So today, on the second day of the festivities, on the **feast of Agios Panteleimon** and in this Holy Church, in addition to the solemn celebration, a **memorial service is held in honor of the great benefactors and donors for its construction**, which has been a **landmark and characteristic work for 60 years in its life in the center of the Community**. And on this occasion, dear friends, in addition to the prayer, it is worth mentioning briefly but also essentially the need to carry out this project that the residents of the time found, decided, and implemented. It was clear, friends, that despite the immigration in the 1950s, the small church below was inadequate for its needs and role. As can be seen from the **texts of the Ecclesiastical Council** at that time, with deed number 5 on January 29, 1960, the land was assigned at the location of Vigla, that is, here. The Parish Committee, as it was called then, consisted of **Anastasios** 

Anastasiou (Priest), Dimitrios Anglezis, Nikolaos Vastis, Ioannis Harakas and Nikolaos Christopoulos.



On **March 13, 1960**, the work of beautifying the site began and then an expense was approved for the transfer of the soil from the Vigla location to Agioi Anargyri. On **June 2, 1960**, the Holy Temple was established and immediately the crews of that era, without machines, went to work. The work was mainly carried out by hand and on **October 23, 1960**, it was confirmed that the outer walls and roof were finished and the amount allocated is 850,000 drachmas, with an additional amount of 700,000 drachmas required.

In **1961**, the work continues, and the amount spent amounts to 950,000 drachmas, the old house of N. Karygiannis is purchased for the extension of the courtyard and the sale of the timber of the fir trees in the precinct is carried out. In **1962**, additional works took place and on **July 7**, **1963**, a vote was passed for the opening of the Church. It is decided to perform them, which takes place with all solemnity and in the presence of the residents on **July 28**, **1963**, by the **Metropolitan of Canada Mr. Anatolios**. Subsequently, on **October 20**, **1963**, it was decided to demolish the old Church and sell its old materials.

After the glorious opening ceremony and the commissioning of the New Church, the Parish Committee meets and announces its Benefactors and Major Donors.

The Commission of that era consisted of Spyridon Kotinis, (Priest) and members Nikolaos Christopoulos, Ioannis Anglezis, Spyridon Prekezes and Panagiotis Diamantouros.



Therefore, according to decision number 7, on October 20, 1963, Ioannis G. Darmos was declared a Great Benefactor.

According to decision number 9 on November 17, 1963, the following were declared:

- Benefactors George K. Costalas and the Arachovite Brotherhood (Adelphotis) of Gastonia Carolina U.S.A.
- <u>Major Donors</u> George N. Charakas, Ioannis P. Stathakis and the Brotherhood (Adelphotis) of Arachovites of Canada.
- Donors Andreas Sar. Trakas, Konstantinos Geor. Voukidis, Demosthenes Geo. Voukidis, Antonios Gr. Karygiannis, Nikolaos P. Seimenis,

Paraskevas Leventis family, Konstatinos P. Mentaulos, Konstatinos I. Karavos, Andreas G. Vastis, Panagiotis N. Charakas, the Brotherhood (Adelphotis) of Arachovites Chicago Illinois U.S.A. and the New England Brotherhood (Adlephotis) of Arachovites (Boston, Massachusetts) U.S.A.

Ladies and gentlemen,

Over the years, the Holy Church acquired an office and a warehouse in the forecourt, and finally, it is only a few years since the canonization was completed with the assistance of expatriates and residents of Karyes. But as is natural, time, which wears everything down, managed to cause serious damage to the tiled roof, but as always happens, the love for the birthplace also did its duty.

The following list of donors, namely Messrs. Diantzikis Vasilios, Dimitroulas Panagiotis, Diantzikis Panagiotis, Kastanas Panagiotis, Koutsogiorgas Panagiotis, Koutsogiorgas Georgios, Kyriazis Theodoros, Bonos Ilias, Darmos Georgios, Skiuris Odysseas, Skiuris Panagiotis, Span Theodoros, Spyropoulos Panagiotis, Sotiropoulou Eleni, Hasapis Konstantinos and the Panagiotis Kerchoulas Trust, help so that the Holy Church of Agios Andreas looks like new, to continue its worship work with the beauty and magnificence that befits the glory of the Saint.

Closing this historical review, we wish for those who departed for the journey of Eternity that their memory on earth be eternal and their glory eternal in the heavens for their contribution to such a great work, and to the living to themselves and their families health and strength.

The General Assembly of residents of Karyes for the year 2024

On the afternoon of Friday, August 19, 2024, the General Assembly of residents for the year 2024 took place at the Karyes Community Building.

The meeting was organized after the Karyes Local Council decision on 15.07.2024 and according to the announcement, the topics to be discussed were:

• "The provision of social or other services to serve the residents of their area (water supply, fire-extraction, etc.).

• Taking measures for the protection of the elderly and children within the framework of the Municipality's social policy.

• The projects to be carried out in the Local Community.

• The provision of services for the tourism utilization and promotion of the Local Community.

• The implementation of cultural, entertainment and sports programs".

Key speakers were the president and the member of the Council of the Karyes Local Community **Mr**. **Panayotis Mentis and Mr. George Dalakouras**, as well as the representative of Karyes in the Municipal Council of Sparta, **Mr. Dimitrios Arvanitis**, who in his capacity as head of the Sparta Municipal Water Supply and Sewerage Company (D.Y.E.Y.A.S.) made an extensive report on the actions that have been taken and are planned to be taken in order to deal with the problem of water shortage that plagues Karyes like so many other parts of Greece.

A dialogue followed with many of the attendees.

It should be noted that both the good organization and the good atmosphere that prevailed also impressed the present vice-mayor, Mr. Pantelis Giannakopoulos, who in his final statement - greeting stated that it should be an example for all the respective Assemblies of the Municipality.

## The first phase of the museum study of the Karyes Memory and Culture Centre and the funding approval for the construction of the stone path to the Caryatid Monument

### Dear Compatriots,

We are pleased to inform you about the positive developments regarding the two projects that the Association has undertaken to carry out in our beautiful village of Karyes Laconia, Arachova of Parnon.

In the great project of the **creation of the Karyes Memory and Culture Center (K.M.C.C.)**, the Association was first registered in the **Index of the Greek Ministry of Culture** by collecting several supporting documents. On 03.14.2024 the Association submitted to the Department of Museums of the Ministry a detailed and painstaking digital application for **funding the required museological study**, which includes three (3) phases.

The request concerned the A' phase and was for an amount of  $\notin$  21,000.00. We are pleased to inform you that our application has been approved for the amount of  $\notin$  **15,000.00**.

#### The first phase includes:

**1.** Collection and study of all available archival and bibliographic material on Karyes (January 2024- June 2024),

2. preparation of an Open Workshop, possibly lasting two days, to inform the inhabitants of the village about the Karyes Memory and Culture Centre, the form the exhibition can take and how the inhabitants themselves can contribute to the creation of content and an
3. on-site collection of stories and artifacts (July to December 2024). Preparation of a list of documents to be utilized and finally – Classification – Documentation – Digitization (December 2024).

In the other project, that of the **construction of the stepped road (path) from the Main Street to the Monument of the Caryatids** and therefore the completion, in this way, of the Monument, as its creators had envisioned, we have good news there as well.

The Karyates Association has been trying for years to find a financier for the construction of the project, which was also **supported by the Karyes Local Councils**. But the Sparta Municipality was unable to find money, despite the occasional promises of the mayoral candidates, and that is why it did not complete the final technical study of the project.

Following this, the Association turned to the **Region of Peloponnese**, where after repeated visits to the **Vice Region of Laconia**, we were promised that it would finance the project as long as the final and certified technical study of the project was presented to it. However, due to the inability of the technical service of the Municipality to compile it, the Association addressed to a private engineer, who, after many efforts and confrontations with the staff of the Technical Service, completed and submitted it.

The Exhibition was checked by the Architectural Committee and finalized in May 2023. All this at a cost of  $\notin$  **2,000.00**. Then it was sent by the Municipality of Sparta to the Region of Peloponnese with a request for the financing of the project.

Despite the pre-election period of the self-governing elections and the repeated promises received by the president of the Association for funding, there was no progress at all and thus the Board of Directors was thoroughly frustrated.

Unexpectedly, at the beginning of June, the **Regional Committee of Peloponnese** chaired by **Mr. Christos Lambropoulos** and with its decision published amended the technical program of 2024. Thus, it committed the amount of  $\notin$  74,400.00 for the construction of the scale. Subsequently, at the Meeting of the **Sparta's Municipal Committee** on **Tuesday**, **August 20, 2024**, the approval of the conclusion of a **Program Agreement between the Region of Peloponnese and the Municipality of Sparta** for the project: "*Construction of a path to the site of the Caryatids monument of the Karyes Local Community*", which was finally **approved**.

### Memorial of the great benefactor Athanasios Matalas from Lakedemon

On the morning of **Sunday August 11<sup>th</sup>**, after the end of the Divine Liturgy in the **Holy Church of Agia Paraskevi**, the memorial service was held in memory of the great benefactor of the place **Athanasios Matalas**, predecessor of the priests **Father Georgios Blathras** and **Father Leontios**.

All the bodies of the village, the President and the members of the Local Council, presidents and members of the Board of Directors. of the clubs and a large number of people were present to honor the memory of this great benefactor.

It should be noted that an honorable mention was given to the former presidents of the villages of **Karyes** and **Vresthena**, **Mr. Devekos** and **Mr. Dimaras**, respectively, for the consistency of their duties during their tenure on the Board of Directors of the **Matalas Foundation** in which they participated due to their position.

We are publishing an article by our compatriot, retired middle school Teacher Mr. Paraskevas Kollantzianos, which was read that day.

Our village, our beautiful Arachova, was fortunate to have many of her children who adored her and benefited her in whatever way each one chose. Some of us younger people either got to know them through their donations or were lucky enough to live with them. But there are also the anonymous ones, those who did not want publicity. We thank all of them from the depths of our souls.

However, our village is lucky because even in modern times its children do not forget it. Their love and their bond with the homelands, wherever they are, is a motivation for great benefits. This is how stadiums, boreholes, aqueducts, renovations of holy temples, paths and anything else that can contribute to the progress of our village has been made.

# But today is an important day for Arachova. It honors its greatest benefactor Athanasios Matalas.

Athanasios Matalas was born in the beautiful Karyes of Lacedaemon from the great generation of Matalas whose roots reach back to Byzantium. His father was Anagnostis Matalas. He learned his first letters in the village and continued at the Greek schools of Agios Petros of Kynouria, Sparta and at the Gymnasium of Tripoli. A restless spirit, thirsty for higher education, he studied at the Law School of the University of Athens (1859-1863) under the guidance of enlightened teachers.

He occupied important positions and coveted titles that many then and now would be jealous of and distinguished himself by leaving his indelible personal stamp. For 20 years (1862-1882) he worked in the **Greek Consular Service** as Secretary, Deputy Consul and Consul and for this he was honored with the **Order of National Services**.

He then served as Secretary and Consul in **Alexandria**, Egypt and **Thessaloniki**. There he made great efforts and managed to establish pure Greek Communities, to govern themselves in order to throw off the Turkish yoke and prevent the propaganda of the Bulgarian nationalists. In 1864 he served in the consulates of **Chania** and **Heraklion** in Crete and in 1864-66 in the consulate of **Constantinople**. In 1866 as vice-consul in **Sulina**, Romania, a large Greek Community - where he found a way to financially support the **Cretan Struggle** (1866-1869). He finished his term in the consular service of **Philippoupolis** (1874-1881) in Eastern Romilia (present-day Plovdiv, Bulgaria).

He played an important role with his activities in favor of the **Macedonian Question** and for this he was honored by the Central **Macedonian Association** in **1905** with an **Honorary Diploma**.

Athanasios Matalas, however, was also **a great merchant**. He imported yarn - being in Philippopolis - tobacco, timber and grain. In **1882** he settled in **Piraeus** where he continued his commercial activities.

As is understandable, he had acquired a large fortune, which is why he limited himself to the Flour Mill located in **Nafplion**. But when the homeland was needed, he willingly offered his services as the Prefect of **Argolida-Corinthia**, **Phthyotida-Fokida** and **Arcadia**, for this reason the Greek Prime Minister **Georgios Theotokis**, a native of Corfu, praised him from the podium of the Greek Parliament as an **indefatigable and successful Local Governor**.

But it doesn't stop there: in **1900** he was elected **Mayor of Oinountas** (the Laconian region of the villages of northern Parnon, including Karyes). Under his guidance, 30 kilometers of roads were opened with the citizen's personal labor. His interest also turned to agriculture, forestry and Local Governance.

In **1882** he founded a **Greek school** in Arachova which he maintained at his own expense for a year. It was a 3-year school between Primary and High School. In **1886** he acted to build a **building for the Primary school** here in Agia Paraskevi. He distinguished himself as a private

The "*Foundation of Athanasios Matalas of Lacedaemon*" which he founded, and which includes the Municipality of Oinountas and a large part of Laconia has far more than 1,000 scholars. He died in **1922** at the age of **86**.

The life and activities of Athanasios Matalas - unfortunately - cannot be included in a presentation that requires a specific timeline. Anyone can fill in infinite details. However, what we ALL owe is to become reverent pilgrims in his memory and grateful for his enormous contribution and, if we can, worthy continuers of his life and his vision for a free country with prospects for the future.

I described his offer as enormous.

When they gave the honor of proposing me as a speaker, I faced a big dilemma: what should I say so that my peers and our even older ones don't think that what I say is too little, and our younger ones - and because our living conditions they are completely different - am I exaggerating?

I'll try to stand in the middle.

Alexander the Great had said the following: "to my parents I owe my life ("zin"), to my teacher I owe my good life ("ef zin")". I paraphrase the word "my teacher" with the word "my benefactor."

Let us ask ourselves, then, how many of us old scholars who faced insurmountable many times, difficulties - even for the tickets for our transfer to the place of our studies, or for the purchase of various aids would have succeeded, small or large, the little or the most that we achieved if that restless, bright mind was not found to secure the "scholarships" for us, so that after finishing the Primary school of our village, we could go on to our high school studies in Sparta and the various University Schools? And this because he saw that the future of our country rests on education.

Today, of course, things are a bit different: a lot has changed: there is greater financial comfort, the children return to their homes free of charge after school every day, they have their hot food and the warmth of the family along with the financial help of Matalas Foundation.

We must note at this point that scholarship holders until **1993** were only **boys**. With the amendment of the will, the **girls** also get a scholarship. That is why we can justifiably be proud of all the educated Arachovites: teachers, professors, doctors, pharmacists, lawyers, notaries, economists, engineers, biologists and anyone else who thrived in their field.

And, while we all expected that conditions would be better and our children and grandchildren would live better, finally, the economic crisis, the energy crisis, the various pandemics, the unemployment rate create insurmountable obstacles that only with cooperation, respect for opinion of the other, honest dialogue can be addressed.

And currently, fortunately, there is no shortage of people who want to contribute in any way. Let us all become a fist and try to be useful in our country. No one is left out.

For the value of sympathy, I only mention this as an example: In the distant 1971, as a candidate for the Faculty of Philosophy, I competed in the exhibition with a theme concerning a dialogue between the righteous Aristides and Themistocles before the naval battle of Salamis. It should be noted that Aristides had been exiled at the initiative of Themistocles - you see there were rivalries even then - and he returned voluntarily in the face of the Persian danger to help. "*We*," Aristides tells him, *"must argue about who will offer more to the Homeland."* To remember our national poet Dionysios Solomos who famously says in a stanza of our National Anthem: "*If they are hated among themselves, they do not deserve freedom*".

individual in the dissemination of the weaving art in the Oinountas municipality and was the **founder** of the **Sparta Gymnastic Association** and served as sports director for 15 years (1898-1912) organizing annual games. Finally, he tried, without success, for the building of the railway connection between the cities of Sparta and Tripolis.

The culmination of all his efforts was his **wil**, that he drew up by hand in **1919** and which is a culmination of his love for his special homeland, Lacedaemon and a sermon of love for youth and Man.

My reference to today has only one goal: **to see our village progress**. Karyes should succeed it and has the right to, because we are happy to see, after many years, young children playing in his squares.

I claim nothing at my 72 years. "I am not dazzled by any passion; I play the lyre and I stand upright with the open mouth of my message."




"20th century, Stories, Traditions, Narratives from the villages of North Lacedaemon"
