#### March: A month full of festivities in Karyes

As stated by the President of the Karyes Local Council, Mr. Pan. Mentis: "During March, the first month of spring, many visitors came at the beautiful Karyes thanks to a series of sports and cultural events that were organized in our village. From March 7 to 10, once again, the international mountain bike races took place. This 4-day event ended with a large number of visitors arriving mainly on the last day, where young cycling Athletes from various cycling Clubs of the Peloponnese participated. Several days later a 3-day carnival festivities took place and our village again became a destination for many young and old. That month ended with the organization of the <<Molon Lave Sprint Rally>>. Organized expeditions of motor sports fans from all over Greece had Karyes as their destination. About 2,000 people visited our beautiful village that day to enjoy the spectacle. The Karyes Local Council would like to thank all the village Clubs and the volunteers who contributed to make these events a complete success."

#### Carnival 2024

Thanks to the warm weather and despite the afternoon rain on Sunday, Karyes was filled with people during the three days of Celebration of Carnival and the Ash Monday as for Greece it's a long weekend. The events which were organized by the Karyes Cultural Club, started on Sunday afternoon in the Central Square with the lighting of a big bonfire with music, dancing and skewers and continued the next day at noon with traditional fasting foods.

The double celebration, the **Annunciation of the Virgin Mary** and the anniversary of the **Greek Revolution of 1821**, was celebrated in the village with splendor. In the flag-decorated church of Ag. Andreas officiated by the priest Father Leontios, a solemn Divine Liturgy was held and "Hypermacho Stratigo" was sung by the children of the Primary School and the whole congregation.

After the end of the service, there followed the recitation of poems by the children of the Primary School as well as a brief history of the Revolution. Afterwards, a trisagio was sung and followed by the laying of wreaths at the monument of the heroes by the new leadership of the Local Council, the representative of the community in the Sparta Municipality, the Primary school and all the village's Clubs and Associations. The ceremony concluded with a minute's silence and the National Anthem. Despite the prevailing cold, many people attended the event.

The dirt races of 2024 started from the beautiful Karyes. The special track of Laconia, extremely popular for drivers and spectators too, has returned to the racing calendar of this year's dirt races. On Saturday 30 and Sunday 31 March 2024, the "Molon Lave Sprint Rally" took place based in our welcoming village, on a well-known technical and spectacular special route from the past that attracted the interest of many crews and spectators.

On Saturday in Sparta, the Administrative and Technical Control took place at the Administrative Office from 13.00 to 16.00. Then followed the Ceremonial Start in the Sparta Central Square at 19.00 and afterwards the crews moved to Karyes and specifically to the Karyatis stadium where the Service Park as well as the reconstruction took place.



Photos from the races On Sunday, the race started shortly several meters after the village of Varvitsa and was completed in three timed passes. A total of 36 crews and another 23 with historic (antiques) cars took part and the entire race was exemplary.



The very interesting 12km route combined slow and fast sections with a wide variety of turns. The road surface was very good but, in some places, it required experience and special management from the athletes. #### Karyes Pharmacy: Termination of its operation and an open invitation




Bad news to the village residents and visitors of Karyes a few days before Easter. The owner of the pharmacy has announced the imminent closure of its operation. According to his related post on Facebook:

"I would like to inform you of a difficult decision that I have to make in the coming days. Almost 8 years ago I made the choice to establish the pharmacy in your beautiful village. All these years I tried to get to know you and for you to get to know me, to honor your trust, your preference.

We shared very beautiful moments (weddings and festivals), but also unpleasant ones (losses of fellow villagers). I have done everything in my power to make your pharmacy a place of primary care and service to the community. You hug me, you made me feel like one of you. My heart would like to continue serving our village, but personal reasons force me to stop operating our pharmacy. I apologize from the bottom of my heart for being forced to make this decision.

I know I will upset everyone who honored me during these 8 years. So I would like to thank you for your love and declare that I feel like a friend and if you will allow me, a member of the village. I promise that for the next few weeks that I will still be present in my role I will try to ensure that I do not leave any unfinished business to all of you who have trusted me."

Having a pharmacy in the village is vital for residents and visitors. Given that its financial viability does not appear to be the reason for its stop of servicing, an appeal is addressed to all patriots, so that anyone who can mediate in approaching pharmacists who would like to open a branch in Karyes to contact the President of the Karyes Local Community Mr. Panayotis Mentis.



#### Easter 2024

As every year, this year there were many visitors to the village during Easter too. The Greek Easter is always combined with spring nature, therefore for many compatriots who live in big cities it was a pleasant opportunity to enjoy the beautiful village's nature. Although the weather was relatively unsettled, the fact that Orthodox Easter was in early May meant that the trees had shed their leaves and the place was lush green.

This year there was a modification of the celebrations, given that the Resurrection would take place in Agios Andreas Church, on Great Friday the service of the epitaph did not start from the Agia Paraskevi Church to end after the procession to Aghios Andreas Church, as it should be due to tradition.

The reason was that the renovation work of Agia Paraskevi, which keep the Church closed. So the liturgy took place in Agios Andreas and the procession of the epitaph, after going down the "steno" street, reached the square of Rachi and returned from the Main Street to the Central Square, where it ended up back in Agios Andreas.

With the improvement of the weather from Easter Sunday until Tuesday (given that the 1st May Day national holiday had been moved) Karyes, as can be seen in the adjacent photo, was full of people every day enjoying the village's cafes and the taverns.

Due to Easter, the celebration of St. George this year took place on Easter Monday and given that the Easter visitors were also in the village, there were many who went in the morning to the "Arachovitikos Kampos" to attend the Divine Liturgy at the recently renovated Chapel that is dedicated to the Saint

#### KARYES FIRE SAFETY TEAM: An interview with its President Mr. Achilleas Sioutos

As we mentioned in the previous issue, this year will be dedicated to the village's clubs and Associations. Therefore, we are publishing the interview given by the newly elected president of the Karyes Fire Safety Clubs, Mr. Achilleas Sioutos, to the head of the Newsletter Editorial Team, Mr. Harris (Charalampos) Konstantopoulos.

Harris Konstantopoulos: Mr. Sioutos, congratulations on your recent election as chairman of the Fire Safety Board of Directors. The Club has been officially operating since 2011. Can you describe its track until toaday?

Achilleas Sioutos: Dear Compatriot Harry, thank you for your wishes. The Club has been operating since 2011 normally and officially as defined by its Statute. Its presence is intense in the summer months when its Board of Directors and its members are constantly alert, especially on difficult days with patrols and an observatory in Kaminia observation post. I would like to inform the readers of the Bulletin that on the website www.Karyes.gr and in the presentation of the Clubs there is a separate reference to the FIRE SAFETY of our village.

**H.K.** In the past the Club had already received equipment such as the fire truck, personal equipment and fire extinguishers. In what state are they today?

**A.S.** The fire engine as well as the three (3) modified tanks on agricultural 4x4 cars are in good condition, maintained and prepared in time for emergencies. All materials acquired from time to time are stored in a special space allocated in the warehouse of the former Agricultural Cooperative. What is required to be replenished are the clothing and masks of the volunteer group that have been worn or consumed over the years. It is worth mentioning that not only there was a strong presence of the Karyes Fire Safety in the great fire of the springs in 2000 and 2007 in Parnonas Mountain, but also a significant contribution to smaller fires (Manari, Kokkinoloutsa, Ai Thodoros, Lakopetra, 'Elato, etc.).

**H.K.** We have recently been informed of the purchase of a new vehicle. Can you describe to us its capabilities as well as how this was acquired?

**A.S.** Regarding the new vehicle that was acquired, we inform you that after the minimal presence of the Municipality and the Forest Service for the cleaning of the zones, the Fire Safety got in touch with Mr. **Panagiotis (Takis) Od. Skiouris**, and with his intervention the **Chicago Adelphotis of Arachoviton** donated to the village a tractor with the necessary parts for a destroyer, fire extinguisher and road cleaner. This vehicle will soon be in the village and will make a decisive contribution to the field of fire prevention and firefighting. Also, we should mention that the equipment has recently been added to the donation from Mr. Skiouris, a 22-ton tank, which will be placed in the "Rogia" area as a water storage.

**H.K.** Given the climate change that occurs in our country in the form of heatwaves in the summer, the absence of snowfall in the winter and rainfall in the spring and autumn and the fact that the existence of the beautiful forest of Karyes which is adjacent to the settlement and is part of the wider forest of Parnon National Forest, what are the preparations and plans you have made so that we are ready to face a forest fire?

**A.S.** For our part, we have these means at our disposal and we are ready for our intervention as quickly and efficiently as possible. In the event of an incident, everyone should know that the Greek National Fire Service is the one that has the authority to give orders, draw up a plan and, under its instructions, help us effectively to deal with any incident.

**H.K.** What needs do you consider existing nowdays, but also in the long term in order to strengthen the work of the Club?

**A.S.** We should point out that, apart from the shortcomings we described earlier, but also covering the financial costs of the machines, the most important thing for strengthening our project is the voluntary spirit, the action, the participation of everyone, especially the young people of the village, if we want to be proud of what nature has beautifully created, in favor of our life and existence. Ending the Board of Directors of Fire Safety warmly thanks **Mr. Takis (Panagiotis) Od. Skiouris** who has been on the side of fire safety all these years as well as the **Chicago Adelphotis of Arachoviton** for donating the Tractor. He also thanks **Mr. Nikos and Mr. Giorgos Pantazopoulos** who financially support the Club in **memory of Christos Dalakouras**, the **Karyes Church Council, Mr. Stavros Mermigas**, as well as all those who have contributed financially to previous years. Also, a thank you to all the young people of the village who, when asked in the summer, stand watch in Kaminia observation post.

H.K. Mr. Sioutos, thank you very much and I wish you success in your difficult task.

#### Stone cleaning of the Diros River Bridge by the Karyes Local Council

A commendable first attempt to protect the historic stone bridge that connects the neighborhood of Pinigoura with the rest of the village, that of the river Deiros, was carried out by the Local Council. As the President, Mr. Pan. Mentis informed us there was a cleaning of the stone surfaces and the result is obvious.

It should be noted that the bridge was built in the 1880s, by Italian craftsmen, and its impressive size and width is due to the fact that the central road connecting the cities of Sparta and Tripoli was intended to pass through it (a plan that was abandoned along the way).

# Special Tribute

# The presentation of the "XARYES PARK", Gastonia N.C.

On the opposite side of the Atlantic on the border between North and South Carolina there is an **Arachovite beacon of Hellenism**, the "**KARYES PARK**". This is an **impressive project** based on a **pioneering idea** of a group of Arachovite immigrants **100 years ago**..



Impressive, because it was built and maintained not by a Greek local community in general, but by a **group of Greek families**, who reside mainly in several Southern States of the U.S.A. and who have one thing in common: they are descendants of immigrants from a certain village, the **Karyes of Laconia**, the historical **Arachova of Parnon**.

Innovative idea, because when it was designed and started to be implemented, in the 1920s it did not exist in the U.S.A. hardly any organized Greek club, or any community. And yet, its founders were not only **pioneers of the American Hellenism**, but had the foresight to infuse this work with features that would ensure its longevity.

Five years had passed since the establishment of the Brotherhood (Adelphotis) and the first major project, that of water supply in the village, had been launched, when it was decided by its leadership to identify a place where compatriots could meet and celebrate. The founders of the Brotherhood wanted to find a place that would remind them of their mountain village, which was difficult since the wider area was flat with small hills. However, after much searching, a suitable area was found near **Gastonia**, North Carolina, at the foot of a small mountain very close to the border with South Carolina, and so in **1928** it was purchased and named, as it were, "*KARYAE PARK*". The area in question was definitively transferred on **October 14, 1929** to the ownership of the Brotherhood and since then its events have been held there.

So, every summer began the **festival** that took place on the weekend after the fifteenth of August (the first festival was held there in August 1928). The compatriots who started to have families and no longer had the possibility to visit Greece regularly, visiting the park lived their Greek moments, meeting their compatriots, feasting in Greek, but also inoculating their children who were born in a new country with the Greek tradition.

The infrastructure construction works also started immediately. Initially, in **1928**, the **Meeting Hall** and the also wooden roofed **Ballroom** were built with timber that was cut within the park, while some rooms were also built for the accommodation of visitors. In the spring of **1930**, a fundraiser was started for the construction of the **chapel of Dormition of the Virgin Mary**, which is inaugurated the same summer. In **1936** the Ballroom was destroyed by fire, but in **1937** it was immediately rebuilt.

At the same time, the Brotherhood continues to improve its facilities and in **1946**, with the end of the Second World War, the **Heroon of Fallen Compatriots** was erected. In the 1950s, after a thirty-year hiatus in immigration, the situation in Greece and in particular the village that has been completely destroyed by the Nazis, creates a new immigration stream and revitalizes the Arachovite/Karyatian community in the area.

Hundreds of young people are immigrating to the Southern States, having been invited by their old immigrant compatriots. They in turn create families and immediately participate in the commons of the Brotherhood.

As a consequence, the new immigrants in turn embrace the park and a major renovation is decided upon. So in 1956 the Administration Building was erected to house the offices of the Brotherhood and the following year, in 1957, the grove was expanded with three (3) additional acres and the New Entrance was built. Finally, the following year, in 1958, the Barbeque Stand was built.

However, the participation of the people is so much that again new infrastructure is needed and so in **1967** the **new Ballroom** (left) is built, while at the beginning of **1970** the **new stone-built Chapel**. Finally, **at the beginning of the 21st century**, the **Meeting Hall** (below) was also renovated, so today the park can be described as a real jewel.
