

# KARYATIS SPORTS CLUB CENTENNIAL CELEBRATION

Karyes celebrated a great historical anniversary this year: a century of presence and contribution of the Community's Sports Club, the famous "KARYATIS". There are not many sports clubs in Greece that can boast, not only of being centuries-old, but also of being able to present an uninterrupted continuous existence and contribution in the sports and cultural everyday life of a place. If we consider that we are talking about a club of a small provincial settlement, we could claim that it should be considered as a significant achievement.

Therefore, this summer the Karyatis Sports Club Board of Directors held a series of festivities and memorabilias, accompanied by an exhibition of historical photographs and relics, a football match and a musical event. On this anniversary, the Karyates Association News Bulletin editorial team together with Mr Theodoris Mentis, who has served as president of the Sport Club for many years, prepared this four-page tribute.



## The Club's profile

The "Karyatis" Sports Club created in **1924** by a group of high school students: George Th. Skiouris, Constantine N. Harakas, Efstratios G. Kostalas, Constantine M. Pitsios, Theodore G. Stathakis, Theodore B. Leventakis, John N. Harakas, John Con. Diamantouros and John St. Macheras. It was officially regognised by the Sparta Court in **1927**.

Today the club has a football field and a basketball, volleyball and tennis court, with bleachers, modern changing rooms and night lighting, as well as an indoor gym (right photo) with exercise equipment and table tennis courts, all privately owned.

# The Club's History

# THE FIRST YEARS

## The first efforts for organized sports activities

After its recognition, the Sports Club participated in the **Athletic Games in Vlachokerasia village** in **1928** and **1929**. Many village's residents accompanied the athletes by car or on horseback. In fact, the athletes from Arachova distinguished themselves by winning first prizes in the events of jumping, shot put, javelin, discus throw, stone throw as well as running. In **1929**, the athletes of Karyatis also participated in the **Sparta Games**, where they won first prizes in the events of 5,000m., 1,500m. with obstacles and in the high jump.

### The construction of the Sport Field

The problem, however, was finding a place where training and matches would take place. The late benefactor G. Th. Skiouris describes in a vivid way how a small space was acquired at the Pinigoura site in order to make the stadium: "We created pits for training in Rachi, in Ai Dimitris and for football we used the small space of the square (breaking some Kaperoneiko houses window glasses), or the threshing floors (alonia) of Pinigoura, where Aunt Eleni Georgiopoulou would chase us with stones and shouts because we were ruining her stone built threshing floor. We also went to the fields of Kato Longos periodically until that lucky field in Pinigoura was found."

This small space of approximately 2 acres, owned by Pan. Papadogiannis, was finally purchased in 1929 by the Club with member contributions, subscriptions from compatriots and with a fundraiser. "I remember and I am moved," says the late G. Th. Skiouris, "the contribution of each member, whether as a student with his pocket money, or as a tailor, or as a worker with his backlog". There were even theatrical performances among with Shadow Theater (Karagiozis) performances too by the late and later hero of the World War II, Major Demetrios Th. Papapageorgiou, with assistant Theocharis Mentavlos, to raise money. The desks were carried on the backs of the members from the school to Rahi Square and then returned in the same way.

# The first soccer team

In the following years, in **1930** and **1931**, Karyatis created a football team for the first time. The sport of football/soccer that had reached the cities of our country also reached Arachova. This first team therefore took part in many friendly football games with teams from Sparta and Krokees.

Unfortunately, all this cosmogony was violently interrupted by World War II, the Nazi Occupation and the complete destruction of the settlement, as well as the civil war conflicts that followed.

### THE POST WAR ERA

#### The sports field conclusion

After the end of the village's tragic decade of the 1940s and while the gradual repair of the houses and infrastructure of the destroyed Karyes had begun, the Club, on the initiative of its president Paraskevas G. Koutsogiorgas and member Konstantinos Mich. Pitsios, encountered the ADELPHOTIS in the U.S.A. Thanks to the support of U\$ 518.00 from the ADELPHOTIS and the LEVENTIS COMPANY, a neighboring plot of land owned by Michael Meleches was purchased in **1951** in order to complete the relevant area of the field. Specifically, 8 contracts were drawn up for an area of 9.221sq.m. at a cost of Drachmas 39.579.00 thousand.

In **1954,** the landscaping and fencing with a stockade wall were completed, at the expense of the great benefactors Paraskevas and Christos P. Leventis, Andreas S. Trakas and Konstantinos Sp. Pitsios, while in 1958, at the expense of Georgios Th. Skiouris, the first changing rooms of the Club's sports field were constructed (still in use today).



#### The first official soccer games

After the completion of the sports facilities, the Club's activity was now multifaceted, athletic, cultural and social.

The Karyatis football/soccer team held a series of 10-15 football matches every summer that were like a fest for the village, since women and children would come out to the field to watch the team. Teams came not only from neighboring villages, but even from Sparta, Skala, Stefania and the Tegea region. Besides, it was the first preference of the teams to play friendly matches with Karyatis, as the village always had a good team, people who filled the field and coolness in the summer.

However, unfortunately this history was not recorded and we do not know the results and teams from that period. Nevertheless, in this year's exhibition, several football player cards of the era were found and exhibited on a special board (photo on the left), while the Club's Board of Directors awarded the veteran football players of that era, Mr. Angelos Matalas, Konstantinos Koutsogiorgas, Panagiotis Darmos, Panagiotis Koutsogiorgas, Spyridon Vlachos (see photo on the right) and Athanasios Kerchoulas.



#### The «Leventis Games», the famous athletic games

But it was precisely at that time that Karyatis became known for the athletics games it organized thanks to the initiative and tireless contribution of the gymnast loannis Chiotis.

Specifically, on September 28, 1958, in the presence of the authorities of the Municipalities of Oinountas and Sellasia, the "1st Leventis Athletics Games" were held. After the parade of the athletes, the raising of the flag and the swearing-in, the coach of Karyatis, gymnast loannis Chiotis, delivered a speech. Subsequently, the president of the Community, Georgios Kaperonis, declared the start of the games, which were a great success since 60 athletes participated, many of whom were from the "Spartiatikos" Gymnastic Club, the Gymnastic Club "Leonidas" of Sparta, Sports Clubs from the villages of Voutiani, Theologos, etc. The winners were awarded cups, medals and diplomas which had been donated by the Karyes Local Community, its president Kaperonis, the teacher Kostalas and George Th. Skiouris.




The Athlete's parade at the 1<sup>st</sup> Levendis Games in 1958

The success was such that the following year, on August 30<sup>th</sup>, 1959, the "2nd Leventis Games" were held, where it is reported that about 150 athletes had flocked from all parts of Laconia and Arcadia. In fact, several of them had participated a few days earlier in the Pan-Peloponnese Games of Patras, thanks to the mediation of the gymnast Anastasios Smyrniotis, a former athlete who was a member of the Panhellenios Gymnastic Club of Athens. Athletes both from Arcadia participated, such as from the "Tegeatikos" Athletic Association (which took first place), "Aris" ("Mars") of Tripoli, "Panarkadikos" Athletic Club of Tripolis, "Iraklis" ("Hercules") of Vervena viilage, clubs from the villages of Pigadakia and Kerasea, as from Laconia, such as from the "Spartiatikos" Gymnastic Club and "Leonidas" from Sparta, "Aster" ("Star") of the village of Vlachiotis, etc.

The Leventis Games were held three more times, the **3rd** on September 4, **1960**, the **4th** on August 13, **1961**, and the **5th** in **1962**. The enormous success was due, as we said, to loannis. Chiotis, who had now been appointed Director of the National Stadium of Sparta and to the above-mentioned veteran athlete of the Panhellenios Gymnastic Club of Athens, Anastasios Smyrniotis, who had now replaced Chiotis as Karyatis' trainer. Indicatively, the opening ceremony of the games was announced by the Prefectural Inspector of Physical Education Megaklis Kanellopoulos, while a team from the Hellenic Army Training Center of Sparta (KEEM) also participated. The prizes were presented by ordinary sports fans to businessmen and personalities from Laconia and Arcadia.


The last Athletics Games took place on August 29, **1965**, and were called "**Karyateia**", also with great success. However, as mentioned, the games preparation required effort, work and money and was very difficult for a village in the Greek province of the 1960s whose population was dwindling due to internal and external migration to continue that.



Of course, throughout that period, **annual school competitions** took place at the Club's sports facilities every spring at the end of the school year, from which photographic material has been preserved and which we publish.

The last significant recorded activity of the Club during that period was its participation in the Laconia 3rd Division football championship in the seasons 1970, 1971 and 1972. The matches were held in the months of April, May and June and almost all the young people of the time participated.

Finally, in 1972, it was declared impossible to finish the championship, so the Karyatis team withdrew in the middle of the season.

### THE ERA 1980-2015

The soccer team's "golden era"

After a period of inactivity, a period of rebirth came at the 1980's. The immigration has essentially mostly stopped and there has now begun to be a trend of repatriation from many Karyates. Although most of those returning to Greece choose Athens and the big cities for permanent settlement, some decide to stay permanently in the village, and of course everyone spends his/her summertime in Karyes. Meanwhile, Greece's accession to the European Union marks the beginning of the implementation of financial programs in the Greek Province.

As a result, the youth in the village began to emerge dynamically again and, in this context, Karyatis became active again. The first project that took place was the expansion of the locker rooms in **1981** at the expense of George Th. Kakaris and so now there are locker rooms for **two (2) football teams**.

After this project, the football team began its participation in 1983 in the local football championships of Laconia, an action that would last for 31 years, until 2015. The management of the Club responded to the demands through the fixed financial support institutionalized by the Greek state, the subscriptions of the members, as well as the donations and the income from various events. It should be noted that, among other things, the publication of anniversary calendars (years 1987, 1988, 1989 and 2000) with photographs of the team and the village.

The presence of the Club was intense, having participated in the Third Division for 15 seasons and the Second Division for 16 seasons, even reaching a step before promotion to the First Division in 2001, where it finished 2nd out of 12 teams. In total, the team played in 539 official games, 257 in Karyes and the rest in 28 other stadiums, scoring 856 goals and conceding 1,050. The first in participations was the current Karyes municipal councilor in the Municipality of Sparta, Dimitrios Arvanitis, with 407 participations in 22 seasons, and the first in scoring goals was the current president of the Community, Panagiotis Mentis, with 47 goals in 162 games.

It should be emphasized here, as a special title of honor for Karyatis, the team's consecutive awards by the Laconia Football Association with "Ethics Diplomas" for the exemplary behavior of its athletes and coaches during the matches in which it participated.

### The construction of the Basketball court

At the same time, however, progress was also made in infrastructure. Above the football field on the land that Karyatis had purchased, there was a smaller terrace with many rocks around it. The great success of the Greek National Basketball Team in 1987, which won the European Championship, turned the youth towards **Basketball** en masse. A sport that many Karyates knew very well from their stay in America. Then the idea "came" to create a space there, where children would play basketball. However, it was found that the space was not sufficient and serious interventions had to be made to open the corresponding area.

The Sports Club managed to secure the first funds by organizing some events and timidly began some renovation work. Thus, in **1994**, the brothers loannis, Panagiotis and Dimitrios Kostalas, who lived, or had lived, in New York, allocated the sum of 1.2 million drachmas for the continuation of the work. This was followed, at the initiative of the Sports Club, by the inclusion of the project in a European Union funding program for an amount of 6.4 million drachmas. The project was put out to tender on **06.15.1994** and finished on **10.04.1996**. This was followed in **1997** and **1998** by the construction of a wall that covered it and cement stands for the fans. So when the project was completed, it has cost 13.4 million drachmas in total and has lines for the sports of basketball, volleyball and tennis.

### The "Skiouris Foundation"

Significant financial support for the work of the Sports Club, from this period onwards, also comes from the "*George Th. Skiouris Foundation*". The compatriot, one of the Club's founders as previously mentioned, and after having served, among other things, as president of the Karyes Community in 1930, subsequently emigrated to Africa (Northern Nigeria) where he worked for several years. Upon his return to Greece, although now a permanent resident of Athens, he lived in Karyes every summer and always loved the Sports Club and therefore, as mentioned, he financed the construction of the changing rooms in 1958. After his death at the age of 75, in 1980, he left a will that continues to benefit our village to this day. Systematic efforts, especially after 1990, by the Club's administration successfully led to the establishment of the Foundation that bears his name on **04.02.1993** by Presidential Decree.

The foundation is managed by a seven-member board and has been operating without problems to this day. In fact, in **1996**, after intervention by the Directorate of Bequests, a plot of land owned by the testator in Alimos, Attica, was utilized and six (6) apartments were delivered that are still rented today. From the net income, the three (3) best students of the 6th grade of the Karyes Elementary School are awarded each year and, indicatively, since the school year 1994-95, over 60 children have been financially supported. Subsequently, the Sports Club is financially supported, since in addition to financing expenses for football matches and athletics events, funds are also allocated to ensure the necessary logistical infrastructure and the improvement and maintenance of the sport facilities.

### The "Karyatia" semi marathon

With the financial assistance of the Skiouris Foundation and the valuable volunteer contribution of its members, the Sports Club managed to organize the Parnonas semi-marathon entitled "THE KARYATEIA" for two consecutive years. The first semi-marathon took place in June **2013** and the second in June **2014** with the participation of dozens of athletes from all over Greece.

### THE MODERN ERA 2015 – TODAY

#### The economic crisis

The economic crisis that hit our country also had its consequences on the course of the Athletic Association. The income from the Foundation was limited and the state support was almost zero. The first consequence was the inability to organize "the Karyatia" again. Also, the participation of the football team in the local championships was interrupted. Of course, the main reasons were, among others, the change in the season, which instead of the summer, when several vacationers could participate, was moved from autumn to spring, the desertification of the villages and the change in the habits and interests of the new generations. Nevertheless, under the tireless leadership of the retired teacher Mr. Theodoros Mentis, the Sports Club not only did not stop its activities, but instead it moved its "energy in other paths".

#### The international mountain bike races and the car rallies

At the level of events, in collaboration with the other village's institutions and Clubs (Local Community, Karyates Association), it supported and supports both financially and by providing its infrastructure, the Motorized Sports and Mountain Biking races that are organized, at the initiative of the Karyates Cultural Club and which have now established Karyes as a reference point for these events nationwide.

Therefore, initially in collaboration with the Sparta Automobile Club, a dirt track was created in the "Souvala" area, specifically on an area of 400 acres next to the settlement of Kalyvia. The route had been designed by the Club, was two (2) kilometers long and there were organized timed racing car races "**Timed Rally Challenge** (TRC)", as well as special dirt racing vehicle races (DUST). Unfortunately, however, this track was unable to renew its operating license.

However, subsequently, on the dirt roads in the Karyes forest, Panhellenic Championship races were organized for both racing cars and motorcycles, bringing hundreds of fans of the sport from all over Greece. In fact, the last event was the "Molon Lavé Rally Sprint", a race of the "Panhellenic Dirt Cup" and the "Panhellenic Dirt Cup for Historic Cars".









Even greater success is enjoyed by the **International Mountain Bike Races** under the name "**Sparta MTB Races**" on specially designed bike tracks in Karyes. These races, which are systematically organized every year, once or twice, also count towards the **Panhellenic Mountain Bike Championship** and are attended by hundreds of cyclists of all ages from all over Greece and dozens of countries abroad. This event is even described as the best of its kind in Greece, making Karyes known to the ends of the world. The coorganizers of the race were the Municipality of Sparta, the Municipal Sports Organization, the Spartan Gymnastic Club and Alterbiketours.

# The acquisition of the cooperative warehouse and its conversion to a modern indoor gum

It also moved to acquire indoor facilities for sports. Therefore in **2014**, the former Agricultural Cooperative of Karyes granted the Sports Club its abandoned warehouse, which had been built in 1973 and operated for approximately 20 years, before it was transferred to the Greek Ministry of Rural Development. The necessary amount was raised with the decisive help of the Greek diaspora abroad, specifically the ADELPHOTIS, the FOUNDATION, N. Kaperonis, Par. Kerchoulas, I. Kyr. Skiouris from the U.S.A. and P. Kontalonis, G. V. Skiouris, An. V. Skiouris, P. Th. Darmos and D. Th. Darmos from Canada, who in total donated the amount of € 9,281.34. The Sports Club paid the remaining amount of € 9,364.86 and the space was acquired, all outstanding tax and notary fees were paid, and the broken windows were replaced.

A hard period followed, where gradually and within five (5) years, the space was cleaned, painted and illuminated with modern lighting. In addition, industrial flooring and new doors were installed, while modern fitness equipment and four (4) table tennis tables (ping-pong) were gradually acquired, and it is now used by athletes.

# The conversion of the sport field to a modern Sports Center

At the same time, the Sports Club administration moved decisively towards the maintenance, expansion and renovation of the infrastructure. First, it completed the issuance of relevant operating permits for all its facilities. In the football stadium, it proceeded with the renovation of the locker rooms (electric power and hot water supply), the new fencing of the stadium, the reconstruction of the stands and its electric lighting with floodlights. In the basketball court, it also proceeded with its electric lighting with floodlights.

### To the future

The recent elections in the Sport Club were of great importance, since they marked the **pass** to the new generation of the village, which is called upon to continue the successful work of the previous ones. According to the declarations, the immediate actions will be the completion of the work on the indoor gym and the start of the collection of the necessary funds for the renovation of the basketball court, with the simultaneous effort, of course, to organize sports events, as far as possible. We hope that everyone stand by them to boost to their efforts.




Availability of Annita Gleka-Prekeze's book "20th century, Stories, Traditions, Narratives from the villages of North Lacedaemon"

Dear fellow Arachovites,

On behalf of the "Adelphotis Arahoviton Ai Karyae" of Gastonia, North Carolina, I warmly welcome you to this year's meeting. I would like to express our sincere gratitude to the Karyates Association for organizing this beautiful meeting of Arachovites, as well as to their Board of Directors for allowing me to provide an update on the Gastonia Brotherhood.

The Brotherhood recently elected a new Board of Directors, and I am honored to serve as President for the next two years.

It has been a year since our great 100th anniversary celebration, which brought back fond memories of Karyae Park's vibrant past with over 600 participants. A special thank you to Haris Konstantopoulos for representing the Karyates Association at this unforgettable event and also for the tribute to Karyae Park in the Association's latest Newsletter.

For over a century, the Adelphotis has achieved remarkable success, providing significant service to the Greek communities of the Carolinas and our beloved village of Arachova. However, we recognize the recent decline of the Gastonia club. Inspired by the success of 100 years, our new Board of Directors has set a series of goals for the next two years to revitalize the Adelphotis.

A key goal is to re-establish a strong line of communication between the Gastonia Adelphotis and the Adelphotis in Toronto, the Karyates Association, and of course with the village itself, including the local administration and its president, Mr. Panos Mentis, the Cultural Club, the Karyatis Sports Club, the Fire Department, the Kerchoulas Trust, and all the village bodies.

I am pleased to announce that our Foundation, led by President Mrs. Eleni Vasti Konti, has planned to resume sending scholarship funds to Arachovites in Greece for their university studies. This had been stopped for a few years mainly due to the fact that Greek banks did not accept checks from the United States. The Board of Directors of the Foundation will finalize the details regarding this and will soon provide information on how students can apply for these scholarships.

Seeing as we are the last chapter of the Adelphotis in the USA, after the closure of the Chicago chapter a few years ago, we ask all Arachovites in the USA to become members of the Adelphotis and have an active role in the club. Together, we can grow the Adelphotis to what it once was.

The Adelphotis has a new website, **karyaegastonia.com**, where everyone can access all the latest information about the club, such as announcements, scholarship information, membership information, payments and much more.

Arachova holds a special place in the hearts of all Arachovites abroad. Through the Adelphotis and all the various associations, we can achieve the ultimate goal - to improve the future of Arachova.

I wish everyone a wonderful summer. God willing, I hope to see you all next summer in beautiful Arachova with my family and the new member we are expecting in November. I am at your disposal for any questions or ideas you may have.


The 100th anniversary celebration of the "Karyatis" Sports Club»
